Scouting at Overstone has been taken place for over 90 years in some shape of form. There have been many changes and additions to the site over that time, but it was here 70 years ago on the 10th May 1952 on a sunny Saturday evening, that the Bishop of Peterborough, Dr Spencer Leeson, performed the act of dedication for the Chapel.

The service on that day was attended by Scouts and their Leaders and was conducted by Rev. George North (Group Scoutmaster of 4th Christ Church) assisted by Rev. J.D. Ashplant. Notable attendees included Eric Chapman, George Moss and Capt. W.H.D. Friedberger, the County Commissioner.

Since then, this Chapel at Overstone Scout Campsite & Activity Centre, has been the centre of prayer, reflection, and remembrance for both Young People and Adults. Today the 14th May 2022 we celebrate over 70 years of use, we will remember loved ones and Scouters that have Gone Home as well as everyone who has suffered during the Covid Pandemic.

As we look back and remember all of times that have gone before us it is also time for looking forward, I'm sure there are likely to be many more changes at this fantastic site in the future, we look forward to the continuing use of this Chapel.
