CaveBus Risk Assessment – This risk assessment covers the general risks that could be experienced when using the CaveBus and how those risks are being controlled by the Overstone Management Team. This risk assessments also identifies further controls that groups using the site should consider or implement.

This RA should be read in conjunction with the Overstone Scout Campsite & Activity Centre – General Risk Assessment.

All users of the CaveBus should use this risk assessment as a reference but must produce their own, based on, but not limited to, the individuals and numbers within their group using the building as well as any equipment they may use. This should include any equipment supplied directly from Overstone or brought in by the Group.

<p>Hazard – Environmental</p> <p>Risk – Heat</p>	<p>All Users</p>	<p>CaveBus is inspected and maintained at regular intervals.</p>	<p>All Scout Groups / Sections, Youth Organisations and other Leaders of groups using or booking the CaveBus should have a Risk Assessment in place to the manage hazard and risk.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Front and rear doors of the CaveBus to remain open at all times during use. • Restrict the number of times an individual is allowed through the tunnelling system. • Refreshments should be supplied by Leader.
